Vision for the Primary PE and Sport Premium

ALL pupils leaving the school will have the **knowledge, skills and motivation** necessary to equip them for a **healthy, active lifestyle** and **lifelong participation** in physical activity and sport

It is expected that the school will see an improvement against the following 5 key indicators:

The school intends to use the funding as stated below:
