



## Primary PE and Sport Premium 2017/18

Vision for the Primary PE and Sport Premium

**ALL** pupils leaving the school will have the **knowledge, skills and motivation** necessary to equip them for a **healthy, active lifestyle** and **lifelong participation** in physical activity and sport

**It is expected that the school will see an improvement against the following 5 key indicators:**

1. Engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity – kick-starting healthy active lifestyles
2. Raise the profile of PE and sport across the school as a tool for whole school improvement
3. Increase confidence, knowledge and skills of all staff in teaching PE and sport
4. Broaden the experience and range of sports and activities offered to all pupils
5. Increase participation in competitive sport

For the financial year (April 2017/March 2018) the school received **£16,324.00** from Sports Premium funding.

Last year the school used the funding as stated below:

Membership in the Havering Sports Collective	£2950.00	Pupils have had the opportunity to participate in competitive sports activities. PE has increased subject knowledge. Advisors from the Collective have provided PE CPD for teachers. This has led to an improvement in the quality of teaching and learning in PE.

Additional extracurricular Sports clubs at lunchtime and after school	£4309.00	<p>More pupils taking part in Sporting activities – an increase of 25% of pupils now take part in some form of physical activity.</p> <p>The school has achieved the Silver School Games Award.</p>
Release time for PE lead to organise competitions and take pupils to tournaments	£1,693.00	The school attended 12 organised competitions and tournaments in football, netball and athletics which provided greater opportunities for pupils
Additional PE support for Newly qualified teachers	£5000.00	PE monitoring showed improved lesson outcomes in these classes
Additional playground equipment	£9,000.00	Increased physical activity at lunch time and play time. This has resulted in calmer and more enjoyable structured playtimes.
